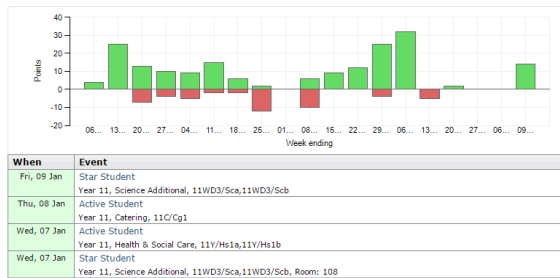


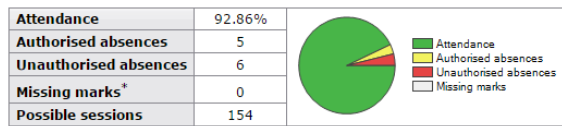

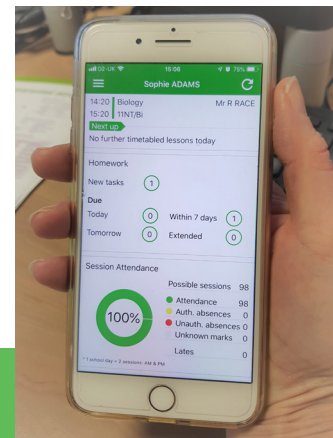

Key module benefits

- Control which headline grades (baseline, target, current, etc) you share with parents and which are for school-use only.
