






Trust attendance trends




Progress 8 comparison

The Trust view allows Trust Leaders and executive head teachers to instantly access a dashboard of contextual information and key performance indicators for all schools – or for subsets of schools – in their Trust, drawn automatically from live data held in GO 4 Schools.

Consistent key data is presented in easy-to-view charts and tables without having to aggregate information from multiple sources, saving the Trust and schools time.

The self-service nature of GO 4 Schools allows Trust Leaders to monitor data trends and track key focus groups that may be of specific interest. Prior attainment data ensures schools with similar intake and contexts can be compared via the key performance indicators prior to reviewing in more depth.

Access to secure, real-time information allows the Trust to work faster with the most up-to-date information, saving time and helping to improve outcomes by identifying and sharing best practice sooner.

Supporting timely school improvement decisions

Regular attainment and attendance data reports from schools to their Trusts are time consuming for senior leaders, data managers and subject leaders to collate. Manual steps often introduce scope for errors and misinterpretation.

Additional time spent by the Trust chasing, collecting, cleaning and manually collating school data is time that could be spent interpreting that data and helping schools. The combined delays represent lost time, and can lead to key school improvement actions and expenditure being made based on out-of-date information.

- Monitor gaps across the Trust by analysing cohort and subject data that mirrors RAISEonline, using built-in focus groups such as Pupil Premium, gender and SEND.
- Monitor consistent custom focus groups across the trust.
- Review and track the effectiveness of interventions and the use of Pupil Premium funding, therefore monitoring value for money and the most effective use of resources across the Trust.
- Use prior attainment data to identify and compare schools with a similar intake and context.
- Demographic focus group data such as Pupil Premium, and summary attendance data are updated from each school's MIS automatically every night. (GO 4 Schools is compatible with most school MISes.)
- Rigorous and future proof, as overnight updates to the web site mean you always have the latest functionality.
- Dashboard view of key data with filtered percentages for focus groups to enable quick and easy comparisons to be made.
- Instant access to the school's homepage to view all headline performance measures for each specific school, and subject residual ribbons.
- Links to OFSTED and the DfE Schools comparison website for validation of in-school data.

What options are there?

GO 4 Schools is a modular system. The Starter version is enough to give the school access to instant online statistics and to give students online access to their individual progress, attainment and attendance information.

A Starter-version subscription is all schools need to share their key data with their Trust via the Trust View, which is a free option for the Trust. Individual schools within the Trust can add-on other modules too, to meet their specific needs.

Whichever modules schools choose, they receive:

- Easy, real-time analysis of performance, attendance and behaviour data by year group, subject, teaching group and focus group.
- The ability to define your own focus groups for analysis, planning and monitoring interventions.
- The ability to capture snapshots of data to allow you to compare "then" and "now" and to track progress over time.
- The ability to link results from external tests such as reading age, to performance, attendance and behaviour data, ensuring the best return from them and giving your staff a 360° view of each student.
- Support for Life after Levels with school-defined grading schemes.
- Automatic, nightly updates of class lists and key student data such as Pupil Premium from your MIS to GO 4 Schools.
- Automatic software updates to all of the modules you are using.
- Access for all staff and students, online, 24/7, with single-sign-on for Windows networks, giving your staff and students one-click access to the information they need.
