Data manager induction training:

New to GO 4 Schools

COURSE DETAILS

The course aims to equip you with the skills and understanding to effectively manage the set up of GO 4 Schools and importing key school data to ensure you are working with high quality validated data sets.

Key aspects covered:

- Subjects and Qualifications (QAN codes and grading schemes)
- Grade types in GO 4 Schools (target and progress grades)
- Uploading target grades and mock exam results
- Handling double Science grades in uploads/downloads
- KS2 / exam grades uploading data
- School internal grading schemes
- Introduction to markbooks (MBs are covered in details in another course)
- Introduction to locating Key Stats for KS3, KS4 and KS5
- Reports and snapshots to view timestamped data and statistics
- Introduction to using data explorers and sharing data sets
- Introduction to student attributes and managing key focus groups

As part of the Data Manager training we offer each delegate a one to one call with the trainer if they would like to follow up on their school set-up in light of what has been covered in the training. This will typically be for 30 to 40 minutes on the same day or very shortly afterwards.
