Provision and Performance

This course is specifically for those staff with a responsibility for Sixth form performance. The course focuses on approaches to tracking data and attainment measures. We aim to ensure you have the knowledge to support improving student outcomes.



COURSE DETAILS

This course is for Heads of Sixth form, Senior Leaders and Data Managers with a responsibility for Key stage 5. We will take you through a range of GO 4 Schools functionality and processes specific to the Post 16 cohort of students.

Key aspects covered:

- Different ways in which Sixth form data can be set up in GO 4 Schools
- A review of the current 16-18 guidelines and DfE Key Performance Measures and what they mean for the analysis of sixth form data
- Understanding Level 3 Value Added (L3VA), and support with disseminating that understanding to others.
- An overview of the Post 16 funding model
- Curriculum planning
- Tracking key groups effectively for Sixth form intervention and evidence
- Departmental and year group tracking and accountability
- Using GO 4 Schools for destinations and additional evidence collation
- Discussion on the Post 16 IDSR and the OFSTED framework for Post 16
- Collating information for UCAS references [Reporting module]
